

## **Atlantic RBCA Guidance for Vapour Intrusion Assessments Version 3.0 (December 2016) Implementation Procedure**

### **Background:**

Since 1997, Atlantic PIRI Regulators have endorsed the use of Atlantic Risk-Based Corrective Action (RBCA) for the management of petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated sites in the Atlantic Provinces. This document recognizes an update to *Atlantic RBCA Guidance for Vapour Intrusion Assessments (July 2006, Errata, July 2012)* with a new version and describes implementation procedures for use in Atlantic Canada.

### **Implementation Procedure:**

Effective **immediately**, Provincial Regulators in Atlantic Canada will require Site Professionals and site owners to use updated [Guidance for Vapour Intrusion Assessments \(December 2016\)](#) for new Environmental Site Assessments.

For ongoing Environmental Site Assessments, Site Professionals and site owners may continue to use the *Atlantic RBCA Guidance for Vapour Intrusion Assessments (July 2006, Errata, July 2012)* version; However, remedial actions (i.e. risk management, site monitoring, etc.) must be completed and reported to the Regulator by **December 31, 2017**. Otherwise, the updated *Guidance for Vapour Intrusion Assessments* must be used.
